POLICY TITLE SCHOOL-COMMUNITY GROUPS

No. 903.1

The board values the participation and the support of school district-community groups, including, but not limited to, the booster clubs, parent-teacher organizations, Johnston Community School Foundation and the Dragon Scholarship Fund which strive for the betterment of the school district and the education program. The board will work closely with these groups.

Prior to any purchase of, or fund raising for the purchase of goods or services for the school district, the group will confer first with the building principal or designee to assure fundraising is in line with the school district's needs and policies. The building principal or designee will then consult with the Chief Financial Officer, as necessary to assist the group in purchasing goods or services to meet the school district's needs.

Funds raised by these groups for the school district may be kept as part of the accounts of the school district. All donations shall be made directly to the school district, rather than any individual or group. The Chief Financial Officer shall be responsible for the purchases of any goods or services with donated funds.

It is the responsibility of the building principal to be the liaison with the school district-community groups affiliated with the building principal's attendance center.
