7th Grade Transition and Scheduling Information from Johnston Middle School

Hello 7th Grade Families!

During the month of January, 7th grade students and families will have the opportunity to learn more about the transition to Johnston Middle School along with scheduling classes for 8th grade. Families will be receiving more information from JMS counselors regarding a virtual parent night and a virtual parent question and answer session.

On January 20th, in-person 7th graders will be watching a video from JMS counselors during basecamp to introduce the 2021-2022 scheduling process for 8th grade. JMS counselors will then be following up with all 7th graders when they visit Summit on January 28th and 29th to complete the scheduling process.

For 7th grade 100% online students, you will also view the scheduling video during a time determined by Mrs. Platt and Mrs. Heidbreder. JMS counselors will then follow up with each of you through breakout sessions to check over schedules.

If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to contact Mrs. Heston at Summit.




## **Summit Health Office**
