Identification for 2017 Extended Learning Programming

We are working on the review process for ELP identification for elementary school students. Each spring, students are reviewed, and letters are sent to those that data shows need support for academic challenge. Usually sent in May, the letter will explain options for your child, including programming available such as extensions in the classroom, an advanced reading class, or a pull-out class on math problem solving. These options depend upon level of service identified as a need, so the letters are specific for each child. While the classroom teacher works with many children, the ELP staff provides direct service to a smaller population.

As a parent, if you are interested in providing input in characteristics you have observed, you may request a form from the ELP staff or go directly to the web link at:

F.A.Q. Our family is moving -- what do I need to do?

If your family is moving to a new residence at any time, including the end of the school year, it is important to contact the Beaver Creek office so that we can help you with your transition. You will need to advise us of your new address, and the name of the new elementary school if known, so we can forward academic and health records once they are requested by your new school.

If you are moving within the Johnston Community School District, we can help you determine which school your student will attend. Within Johnston, you must attend the elementary school whose boundaries your residence falls within.

Registration for 2017 / 2018 **School Year**

Many of you have asked about Registration for the 2017/2018 school year. This year, the registration process will be completely online. We expect it to open to families at the end of March, or beginning of April. As soon as I find out the confirmed date, I will advise all families.

When we post the reenrollment link on parent portals this spring you will need to know how to retrieve your usernames and passwords if you have forgotten them or have never set them up.

How does the Self-Serve Password Reset work? A parent hits the blue link on the bottom of the Infinite Campus banner page (link below) and answers six questions. The parent will get a confirmation email that their request has been received and that a response will follow within 20 minutes. Then they will get a second email with the reset username and password. It is really that easv!
