Information about location: Living History Farms tells the amazing story of how Iowans transformed the fertile prairies of the Midwest into the most productive farmland in the world. While at the 500-acre open-air museum, visitors travel at their own pace through historical time periods spanning 300 years. On-site interpreters provide a unique learning environment of seasonal activities and demonstrations.

What do KTC participants do at this location: Students will tour the farms and historical towns. They will be split into groups upon arrival and will move from farm to farm while learning about what has made Iowa agriculture and history great and what it is today.
