Online courses and work completion are different from completing class work in a school building. The following points are provided to assist you as a parent in supporting your child in online learning. Our online teachers will work with you as partners to support your child's learning during the 2020-2021 school year.

- If you or your child have questions, contact the online teacher, don't wait.
- Please read all communication from the online teacher and if your child is able to read, have them read all communication as well.
- Your child should respond to the teacher to acknowledge he/she has received the information and understands the information.
- As a parent help your child manage their time and encourage your child to stay on track with the weekly pacing providing in the online courses. You have the flexibility to develop a study schedule which meets your family's needs as the delivery is through the software program.
- Work with your child to develop a study schedule and create a study or learning space in your home for your child to work.
- Support and assist your child with his/her learning but do not do the work for them.
- Encourage your child to have regular contact with his/her teacher and to contact the teacher with questions, for support and feedback.
- Contact your child's teacher if you have questions or concerns about your child's learning.
