Outdoor Recess Guidelines

Recess will be held indoors when: (a) the temperature has a wind chill factor of 5 degrees or heat index of 95 degrees; (b) precipitation would cause outdoor activities to be uncomfortable (heavy snow, sleet, rain); (c) when extreme wind and/or humidity factors make outdoor recess extremely uncomfortable. Students will be expected to be prepared to go outdoors for recess on all other days. If the students are indoors for a recess they will be involved with quieter activities in their classroom.

Volunteering

The Johnston Community School District uses the Background Investigation Bureau (BIB) system to screen volunteers for different roles within our schools. For example, some volunteers are asked to work with students on academic skills, while other volunteers are needed to assist with special events or large school functions. Regardless of the role, we want to ensure the safety of our students and staff, thus we have contracted with BIB to conduct high quality background checks on our potential volunteers using their Secure Volunteer technology.

Secure Volunteer is an easy to use online system created to help school systems manage volunteer screening. Use the secure online system to request your background check with just a few steps. Once your background check is complete, we will review and notify you by email when you have been approved. You will also receive a Secure Volunteer ID card to verify your background screen has been completed. It takes less than five minutes to complete!

This does need to be completed every three years and this is the third year the district as been doing this. Many volunteers might need to complete the background check again. Please check your card for expiration date and should receive and email from BIB for a renewal. This is required for any parent volunteering in a classroom or chaperoning a field trip.
